Notification of Public Consultation on Main Modifications to the Fareham Local Plan 2037

The Fareham Local Plan 2037 is undergoing independent examination by the government appointed Planning Inspector Helen Hockenhull BA(Hons) B.PI MRTPI. The Inspector has been assessing the soundness and legal compliance of the Plan which the Council submitted in September 2021, taking into consideration the written representations received throughout the Plan's preparation and verbal representations at the hearing sessions that were conducted in March and April 2022.

The Inspector has now proposed a list of amendments to the plan, known as main modifications. Main modifications are those that materially alter the Plan and are identified by the Inspector to ensure the Plan is sound and legally compliant. The Inspector has requested that the proposed main modifications to the Local Plan be consulted on for a period of six weeks in order that interested parties can express their views on these changes.

The Fareham Local Plan 2037 with Main and Additional Modifications Shown

The Council have published a modifications version of the Plan which sets out the proposed main modifications and additional modifications. In order to identify the modifications, **the main modifications are set out in bold and underlined** and the <u>additional modifications are set out in</u> <u>italics and underlined</u>. Where text is proposed to be removed it is shown as struck through: proposed deleted text. In addition, the modifications are identified with a reference which relates to the relevant modification schedule, either MM(ref) for main modifications or AM(ref) for additional modifications.

Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulations Assessment

Updated Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulations Assessment reports accompany this consultation. The purpose of these reports is to show how sustainability considerations have been incorporated and assessed as part of the modifications to the Plan and to ensure that the proposed modifications to the Local Plan do not result in any adverse effects on designated sites.
